JULIETTE LOW FUND SKIT

As the story is read, players do the actions described.

Juliette Low – join hands with persons on the right and left Scout/Scouting – smile and give a salute

World – Stand up, spin around once and sit down

In 1912 <u>Juliette Low</u> became interested in <u>Scouting</u> while visiting her friends. Lord and Lady Baden Powell, who lived in England and who started Boy <u>Scouting</u> and Girl <u>Scouting</u> in their part of the <u>world</u>

When <u>Juliette</u> came back to America, she thought <u>Scouting</u> was so wonderful that she decided to start the first Girl <u>Scout</u> Troop in her home town of Savannah Georgia. This she did on March 12th, 1912, and this first little Troop of 8 girls was the first Girl <u>Scout</u> Troop in this part of the <u>world</u>.

This first Girl Scout Troop was so successful that Juliette wanted to see Scout Troops all over the world because she knew that Scouting would help girls all over the world to become friends and to help build world peace and goodwill.

Girl <u>Scouting</u> grew and grew until now you are not only a member of your own little Troop but also a member of the Girl <u>Scouts</u> of America and the <u>World</u> Association of Girl Guides and Girl <u>Scouts</u>. (WAGGGS)

<u>Juliette Low</u> died in 1927 and her friends wanted to pay her a great tribute. They knew that her greatest dream was of <u>world</u> friendship and <u>world</u> peace and that she hoped to accomplish this through Girl <u>Scouting</u>. So her friends started a memorial fund in her honor and called it the <u>Juliette Low World</u> Friendship Fund and each year all <u>Scouts</u> in the USA contribute to this fund, which helps <u>Scouting</u> all over the <u>world</u>.

Your contributions to this fund will travel to all parts of the <u>world</u> and help <u>Scouts</u> in many ways. Maybe it will help send older <u>Scouts</u> from our country to our chalet in Switzerland, where <u>Scouts</u> from all over the <u>world</u> get together to exchange ideas and to help build <u>world</u> peace.

We have no way of knowing how far our contributions may travel. We have no way of knowing in what ways it may be returned to us in new friendship and <u>world</u> peace. But we do know that the <u>Juliette Low World</u> Friendship Fund is doing a lot of good.

We do know that we are helping the fund to spread Girl <u>Scouting</u> around the <u>world</u>. When we make our contributions to the <u>Juliette</u> <u>World</u> Friendship Fund.
